1. Position

One fixed term (five years) Assistant Professor (for female researchers only)

Notes: After the end of the 3rd year during the fixed term, she can apply for a tenure position.

A tenure position will be granted on the basis of multi aspects such as education, research, campus activities and social contribution of an applicant.

2. Duties

- 1) Teaching polymer chemistry related subjects
- 2) Assisting in the supervision of undergraduate and graduate research
(All the faculty members are responsible for general education classes and evening classes)
- 3) Research of polymer chemistry including polymer synthesis, functional polymers, degradable polymer, environmental chemistry, and bio-related polymer.

3. Qualifications

- 1) Young people with a doctorate degree or an expected doctorate degree
- 2) Enthusiasm for teaching either research of polymer chemistry and soft materials
- 3) An adequate command of Japanese to manage daily university works

4. Salary and Benefits will be determined according to the university regulations.
