- 3) Summaries of 3 representative publications.
- 4) A history of obtaining external funding (Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research, Contract Research Funds, Joint Research Funds, Scholarship Donations, Research

Grants, etc. Include the name of the fund, the year, the research theme, the amount, and distinguish between the lead researcher and participant researcher).

5) A summary of research to date and a plan for future research (2,000 Japanese characters).

6) An explanation of your philosophy of teaching English. Include information regarding teaching English to engineering students (2,000 Japanese characters)

7) The names and contact information of one or more references
