

# Nagoya Institute of Technology Regulations on Tuition Fee and Other Fees

Established April 1, 2004

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### **Chapter I** General Provisions

(Objectives)

**Article 1** This regulation shall apply regarding fees such as tuition fee and other fees at Nagoya Institute of Technology (hereafter referred to as “the Institute.”)

### **Chapter 2** Tuition Fee, Examination Fee and Admission Fee

(Amounts of Tuition, Examination and Admission Fee for Undergraduate and Graduate School Program)

**Article 2** The amounts of tuition, examination and admission fee for undergraduate program and graduate school program shall be as shown in Appendix 1.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, the annual amount of tuition fee collected from students permitted to graduate or complete the curriculum by systematically undertaking the curriculum for a fixed period beyond the Institute's period of study or standard period of study as stipulated by the Institute, only for the period during which the student is admitted (hereafter referred to as the “long-term enrollment period,”) shall be the amount obtained by multiplying the annual tuition fee prescribed in the same paragraph by the number of years equivalent to the Institute's period of study or standard period of study divided by the number of years of the long-term enrollment period (fractions of less than 10 yen in this amount shall be rounded up.)
3. At the Faculty of Engineering, selection shall be made based on application documents (hereafter referred to as “first stage selection,”) and only those who have passed the selection shall be selected by academic ability testing or other means (hereafter referred to as “second stage selection.”) The amount of the examination fee in this case shall be as shown in Appendix 2 regardless of the provisions of paragraph 1.

4. Regardless of the provisions of paragraph 1, the amount of examination fee for transfer between Departments in the Faculty of Engineering, mid-course admission, or readmission shall be as shown in Appendix 3.

(Payment of Tuition Fee)

**Article 3** Tuition fee stipulated in Article 2, paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be collected in the first and second semesters of each year respectively. The amount collected in each period shall be equivalent to half of the annual amount.

2. Tuition fee set forth in the preceding paragraph shall be collected in April in the first semester and in October in the second semester.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding two paragraphs, if requested by a student, tuition fee for the second semester of the relevant year shall be collected paid together with tuition fee for the first semester.
4. Regardless of the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2, if requested by a student who has been enrolled, tuition fee for the first semester or the first and the second semesters of the enrollment year shall be paid when admission is approved.

(Method for collecting from students for whom permitted exemption from tuition fee has been revoked, and students for whom deferral of payment has been permitted.)

**Article 4** Regarding for a person that has obtained permission for exemption from tuition fee, if the reason of the permission for the exemption was revoked due to such reason no longer exists, the amount obtained by following formula, dividing the tuition fee for the exempted first and/or second semesters by the number of months in the first and/or second semesters and multiplying it by the number of months from the month to which the date of cancellation belongs to the month at the end of that period, shall be paid in the month in which cancellation occurred. However, if permission for exemption is revoked because it turns out there is fraud, the full amount of the tuition fee for the exempted first and second semester shall be paid in the month in which cancellation occurred.

2. Tuition fee from students granted permission to defer payment shall be paid during the month in which the deferment of payment expires. However, if the reason for deferment of payment no longer exists, such fee shall be paid in the month in which the reason ceases to exist.
3. Tuition fee shall be collected monthly from students receiving permission to defer payment of tuition fee by paying monthly. However, the portion for the holiday period shall be collected before the start of the holiday period.
4. If a student having received permission to defer payment of tuition fee (including deferment of payment by paying monthly installments) withdraws from the Institute, the amount due to be paid during that period shall be paid when withdrawal is permitted.

(Amount of tuition fee and method of payment in case of reinstatement to the Institute)

**Article 5** The amount of tuition fee to be paid in the first or second semester from students reinstating, transferring, enrolling mid-course or readmission (hereafter referred to as “reinstating to the Institute”) midway through the first or second semester shall be equivalent to 1/12th of the annual tuition fee (fractions of less than 10 yen in this amount shall be rounded up, the same shall apply hereafter) multiplied by the number of months from the month of reinstating to the Institute to the next collection payment period, and shall be paid in the month in which the student returns to the

Institute.

2. In the case of a person taking leave of absence after paying the tuition fee for the first and second semesters and returning to the Institute during the period, the provisions of the preceding paragraph do not apply to tuition fee for this period.

(Amount of Tuition Fee and Method of Payment When Graduating or Completing in the Middle of the Academic Year at the Institute)

**Article 6** The amount of tuition fee paid by students graduating or completing a course in the middle of the academic year due to special circumstances shall be the amount obtained by multiplying the amount equivalent to 1/12th of the annual tuition fee by the number of months enrolled, and shall be paid in the first month of the relevant academic year. However, if the month of graduation or completion of the course is after the payment period for the second semester, tuition fee for the period of enrollment after this payment period shall be paid during the second semester payment period.

(Amount of Tuition Fee in Case of Withdrawal)

**Article 7** The amount of tuition fee paid by students withdrawing before the second semester payment period shall be equivalent to half of the annual tuition fee (fractions of less than 10 yen in this amount shall be rounded up.)

(Special provisions for tuition fee and payment methods for students permitted to graduate or complete a course by studying beyond the period of study in a planned manner.)

**Article 8** The amount of tuition fee to be paid when a student whose annual tuition fee are set by the provisions of Article 2, paragraph 2 graduates or completes the course midway through the school year shall be the amount obtained by following formula, multiplying the amount equivalent to 1/12th of the annual tuition fee in accordance with the provisions of that paragraph (fractions of less than 10 yen in this amount shall be rounded up) by the number of months enrolled, and shall be paid in the first month of the relevant academic year. However, if the month of graduation or completion of the course is after the payment period for the second semester, tuition fee for the period of enrollment after the second semester payment period may be paid during the second semester payment period.

2. If a student whose annual tuition fee is set according to the provisions of Article 2, paragraph 2 is permitted to shorten the long-term enrollment period, an amount obtained by subtracting the total amount of tuition fee due for the duration of study (If during the school year, the period until the end of the school year. The same shall apply hereafter.) from the amount obtained by multiplying the annual tuition fee calculated according to the provisions of the same paragraph according to the shortened period by the number of years of study (fractions of a year shall be rounded up. The same shall apply hereafter.) shall be paid when shortening of the long-term enrollment period is approved. However, if the period after shortening corresponds to the duration of studies or the standard duration of studies, the amount obtained by deducting the total amount of tuition fee that should be paid by the student in the period of enrollment from the amount obtained by multiplying the annual tuition fee prescribed in Article 2 paragraph 1 by the number of years enrolled shall be paid.
3. If the period of enrollment is exceeded due to academic years repeated, etc., the amount of tuition fee stipulated in Article 2, paragraph 1 shall be paid.

4 When calculating the difference when shortening the period of enrollment, the amount of tuition exempted by the tuition exemption system for leave of absence is included in the total tuition fee to be paid during the period of enrollment of the student concerned.

5. If an extension or shortening of the period of enrollment is permitted midway through the academic year, the new tuition fee stipulated by the provisions of Article 2, paragraph 2 shall be applied from the following year.

(Payment of Examination Fee)

**Article 9** Examination fee stipulated in Article 2, paragraphs 1, 3 and 4 shall be paid when an application for admission, transfer between Departments, mid-course admission, or readmission is accepted.

(Payment of Admission Fee)

**Article 10** Admission fee stipulated in Article 2, paragraph 1 shall be paid after the applicant has been notified that he/she is permitted admission, transfer between Departments, mid-course admission, or readmission, and has completed the required procedures for enrollment.

(Return of Paid Tuition)

**Article 11** Paid tuition fee, examination fee, and admission fee are not refundable.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, if a student who has paid the tuition fee when admission was approved subsequently withdraws before the start of the academic year, the tuition fee shall be returned upon his/her submission of application for same.

3. Regardless of the provisions of paragraph 1, students who have paid the tuition fee for the first and second semesters based on the provisions of Article 3, paragraphs 3 and 4 and have taken leave of absence or withdrawn before the time for collection of tuition fee for the second semester, shall be refunded the amount equivalent to the tuition fee for the second semester.

4. Regardless of the provisions of paragraph 1, for examination fee prescribed in Article 2, paragraph 3, the total of the amount related to the first stage and second stage selection shall be paid upon application. For students failing the selection in the first stage, the amount equivalent to the amount related to the selection in the second stage shall be returned upon request. However, this does not apply in cases in which a separate academic ability test, interview or essay, etc., are conducted in addition to application documents in the first stage selection (e.g. with recommended enrollment).

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1, for students found to be unqualified due to lack of subjects for the Common Test for University Admissions after accepting individual academic ability test applications, the amount of refund for persons unqualified for application specified in Appendix 4 shall be refunded upon request.

(Those Who are Exempted from Tuition Fee, Examination Fee, and/or Admission Fee)

**Article 12** Tuition fee, examination fee and admission fee for international students on MEXT scholarship shall be exempted.

2. Examination fee and admission fee for those who have completed the master program at the graduate school in the Institute and proceed to the doctoral program at the graduate school of the Institute shall be exempted.

3. Examination fee and admission fee for special undergraduate students, special graduate students, and special graduate research students shall be exempted.

4. Tuition fee for students prescribed in the previous paragraph if they are students of national universities shall be exempted.
5. Tuition fee, examination fee, and admission fee shall be exempted if there is a student exchange agreement concluded regarding the fee exemption with a foreign university.
6. Tuition fee, examination fee and admission fee shall be exempted if there is a mutual credit transfer agreement and/or a special graduate research student exchange agreement concluded regarding fee exemption.
7. Examination fee, admission fee and tuition fee for students transferring through a twinning program based on an agreement with a foreign university specified in the Appendix 5-1 shall be exempted.
8. Examination fee, admission fee and tuition fee shall be exempted when accepting students in high school majors as credited auditors based on the high school-university cooperation agreement stipulated in Appendix 5-2.
9. Tuition fee for special undergraduate students, special graduate students, and special graduate research students based on the European Union (EU) grant program (Erasmus+ Program) shall be exempted.
10. Admission fee and tuition fee for students who have completed the admission procedures at the University of Wollongong for “Nagoya Institute of Technology and University of Wollongong Joint Degree Doctoral Program in Informatics” shall be exempted.
11. Based on the agreement of the Graduate Student Overseas Study Program implemented by Chinese government, tuition fee, examination fee, and admission fee shall be exempted for students who enroll in the doctoral program at our graduate school.

(Amounts of tuition fee, examination fee and admission fee for research students, credited auditors, auditing students, special undergraduate students, special graduate research students, and short-term acceptance international students)

**Article 13** Tuition fee, examination fee and admission fee for research students, credited auditors, auditing students, and special undergraduate students, short-term acceptance international students, graduate research students, non-degree graduate students, graduate student auditors, special graduate students, and special graduate research students are as shown in Appendix 6.

### **Chapter 3** Research Fee, Training Fee, Dissertation Examination Fee, and Document Copying Fee

(Research Fee, Training Fee, Dissertation Examination Fee, and Document Copying Fee)

**Article 14** Amounts of research fee, training fee, dissertation examination fee, and document copying fee shall be as follows.

- 1) Research fee for private school trainees, vocational school trainees, public college trainees, and public university trainees are as shown in Appendix 7.
- 2) Research fee for visiting research fellows shall be as shown in Appendix 8.
- 3) Research fee for private-sector joint researchers shall be as shown in Appendix 9.
- 4) Research fee for inland researchers shall be as shown in Appendix 10.
- 5) Training fee for international project trainees shall be as shown in Appendix 11.
- 6) Training fee for industry-academia collaboration practical trainees shall be as shown in Appendix

12.

7) Doctoral dissertation examination fee shall be as shown in Appendix 13.

8) Library document copying fee shall be as shown in Appendix 14.

(Payment of Dissertation Examination Fee)

**Article 15** Doctoral dissertation examination fee shall be paid when the application for conferral of a degree is accepted.

#### **Chapter 4 Accommodation Fee**

(Amounts of Accommodation Fee)

**Article 16** Amounts of accommodation fee shall be as shown in Appendix 15.

(Payment of Accommodation Fee)

**Article 17** Monthly accommodation fee shall be paid every month from the month of entry to the month of leaving the accommodation. However, the portion for the holiday period shall be paid before the holiday period.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, if a student offers or consents, the amount related to the offer or consent may be paid at that time up to the total amount of the accommodation fee to be collected within the relevant fiscal year.

#### **Chapter 5 Other Fees**

(Amounts of Other Fees)

**Article 18** Apart from the fees specified in Chapters 2 to 4, the fees specified in the following items shall apply.

1) Commissioned examination fee shall be as stipulated in Article 4 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Commissioned Tests Handling Regulations.

2) Acceptance costs associated with the establishment of industry-academia collaborative research courses shall be as stipulated in the second Article in the Nagoya Institute of Technology Rules regarding establishment contract for the industry-academia collaborative research course/ industry-academia collaborative research Section.

3) Extension Course fee shall be as stipulated in Article 8 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Extension Course Regulations.

4) License renewal training fee shall be as stipulated in Article 7 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology License Renewal Training Implementation Rules Article 7.

5) Course fee for the course certification program shall be as stipulated in Article 10 of the Handling Rules for the Course Certification Program of Nagoya Institute of Technology.

6) Land/ building and other property loan fee shall be as stipulated in Article 7 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Asset Loan Regulations.

7) Staff hall usage charges shall be as stipulated in Article 7 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Rules on Staff Hall Rules.

8) Incubation facility charges shall be as stipulated in Article 9 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Incubation Facility Detailed Regulations.

9) Tajimi Exchange Center usage charges shall be as stipulated in Article 9 of the Tajimi Exchange

- Center Usage Rules, Advanced Ceramics Research Center, Nagoya Institute of Technology.
- 10) Accommodation fee for staff shall be as stipulated in Article 13 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Accommodation Management Regulations.
  - 11) Fee for maintenance and management of the Innovation Center for Multi-Business of Nitride Semiconductors cleanroom shall be as stipulated in the Nagoya Institute of Technology Innovation Center for Multi-Business of Nitride Semiconductors Operation Rules Article 4.
  - 12) Fee for use of the Innovation Center for Multi-Business of Nitride Semiconductors cleanroom equipment shall be as stipulated in the Nagoya Institute of Technology Innovation Center for Multi-Business of Nitride Semiconductors Operation Rules Article 5.
  - 13) IC card reissue fee shall be as stipulated in Article 2, Nagoya Institute of Technology Handling Procedure Regarding Fee for Reissue of IC Card
  - 14) Lost library card fee shall be as specified in Article 2, Nagoya Institute of Technology Handling Procedure Regarding Fee for Lost Library Card.
  - 15) Information disclosure implementation fee shall be as stipulated in Article 12 of the Nagoya Institute of Technology Information Disclosure Handling Regulations.
  - 16) Fee for requesting disclosure of corporate documents shall as stipulated in Article 4 of the Detailed Handling Regulations for Methods for Disclosure of Corporate Documents, Disclosure of Request Fee, and Disclosure Implementation Fee at Nagoya Institute of Technology.
  - 17) Fee for requesting disclosure of retained personal information shall be as stipulated in Article 3 of the Detailed Handling Regulations for methods of disclosure of retained personal information and fee for requesting disclosure at the Nagoya Institute of Technology.
  - 18) Fee for providing non-identifiable processed information for independent administrative agencies shall be as stipulated in Article 12 of the Handling Regulations for the Provision of Non-Identifiable Processed Information for Independent Administrative Agencies at Nagoya Institute of Technology.

## **Chapter 6** Methods of Determining Fees

(Methods of Determining Fees)

**Article 19** In addition to those stipulated in Chapters 2 - 5, the Financial Affairs Division and the Executive Director of Financial Affairs shall consult in advance when establishing or revising fees to be paid at the Institute.

## **Chapter 7** Deliberations of Committees

(Deliberations of Committees)

**Article 20** When amending the tuition fee, examination fee, and admission fee stipulated in Chapter 2, the President shall determine such fees after deliberation by the Administrative Council and discussion by the Board of Directors.

2. When establishing or revising fees other than the fees specified in the preceding paragraph, the Steering Committee shall coordinate opinions and consult with the relevant committees.

## **Chapter 8** Miscellaneous Provisions

(Miscellaneous Provisions)

**Article 21** In addition to those stipulated in this regulation, relevant matters regarding tuition and other fees shall be stipulated separately.

Supplementary Provisions

These regulations shall come into effect from April 1, 2004.

Supplementary Provisions

These regulations shall come into effect from April 1, 2005.

Supplementary Provisions

These regulations shall come into effect from September 14, 2006.

Supplementary Provisions

These regulations shall come into effect from April 1, 2007.

Supplementary Provisions

These regulations shall come into effect from October 1, 2007.

Supplementary Provisions (March 25, 2014, Regulation No. 29)

These regulations shall come into effect from April 1, 2014.

Supplementary Provisions (November 2, 2016, Regulation No. 4)

These regulations shall come into effect from November 2, 2016.

Supplementary Provisions (September 14, 2017, Regulation No. 4)

These regulations shall come into effect on September 14, 2017 and shall be applied from July 17, 2017.

Supplementary Provisions (February 5, 2018, Regulation No. 16)

These regulations shall come into effect from March 1, 2018.

Supplementary Provisions (February 13, 2018, Regulation No. 19)

1. These regulations shall come into effect from April 1, 2018.
2. Accommodation fee for students moving into the student dormitory (Kowa dormitory) shall be 6,000 yen per month for academic year 2018.
3. Students moving into the International House Buildings A, B and C before March 31, 2018, will be charged the monthly accommodation fee before revision of 5,900 yen for Building A, 14,200 yen for Building B, and 9,500 yen Building C.

Supplementary Provisions (March 11, 2019, Regulation No. 25)

These regulations shall come into effect from April 1, 2019.

Supplementary Provisions (July 3, 2019, Regulation No. 8)

These regulations shall come into effect from July 3, 2019 and shall be applied from July 1, 2019.

**Remarks**

Regardless of this table, annual tuition fee for students enrolled in undergraduate program (day course) in academic years 1995 and 1996 shall be 447,600 yen, and annual tuition fee for students enrolled in 1997 and 1998 shall be 469,200 yen. Annual tuition fee for students enrolled in the undergraduate program (evening course) in 1994 shall be 205,800 yen, annual tuition fee for students enrolled in 1995 and 1996 shall be 223,800 yen, and annual tuition fee for students enrolled in 1997 and 1998 shall be 234,600 yen. Annual tuition fee for students enrolled in the graduate school (doctoral course) in 1997 and 1998 shall be 447,600 yen, and annual tuition fee for students enrolled in 1999 and 2000 shall be 469,200 yen.
