NITech and University of Wollongong have been collaborating in educational activity for many years in the field of informatics, mainly artificial intelligence and multi-agent system. We will begin a new Doctoral Degree Program of Joint Degree Doctoral Program in Informatics to enable mutually complementary education and research by taking advantage of the strengths and unique feature of each university in March 2018. This Program will confer a single degree jointly to students who complete it. This program trains researchers lead the new research field in the informatics to realize a super smart society and contribute fourth industrial revolution.

This program also trains practical researchers and engineers as a global leaders lead the development of new business in the global enterprises including IT related corporation that deploy internationally.

University of Wollongong is a public university located in Wollongong, New South Wales, Australia founded in 1951. University of Wollongong is a comprehensive public university with about 33,000 students, and an International university with its 40 % of the students are from overseas.

04 Concluded Agreement for Large-Scale Disaster Response for National Universities in the Tokai Region

On June 14th, 2017, eight national university corporation in the Tokai Region (Nagoya University, Gifu University, Shizuoka University, Hamamatsu University School of Medicine, Aichi University of Education, Nagoya Institute of Technology, Toyohashi University of Technology and Mie University) concluded "The Agreement for Large-Scale Disaster Response of National University Corporation in Tokai area" during a meeting at the Gakushikaikan in Tokyo. The agreement aims to promote "partnership and cooperation in times of disaster" as well as "collaboration in times of peace," based mainly on the assumption that large-scale natural disasters may affect a wide area of the Tokai Region in the future, such as an earthquake in the Nankai Trough. The agreement also arranges for cooperation in cases where a certain university is damaged by an inland earthquake, torrential downpours, etc.
