## 01 **Topic** Commencement and Spring Entrance Ceremony in 2018

Commencement was held on March 26th , 2018 at NTK City Hall. 28 Doctoral, 688 Master and 925 Bachelor, in total 1,641 of graduates were granted degree diplomas.

Also, on April 6th , 2018, the Entrance Ceremony at NTK City Hall was held and 995 students (Day courses), 20 students (Evening Courses) for Faculty of Engineering, 735 students for Master course and 43 students for Doctoral course enrolled.
