Regarding COVID-19 Vaccinations (On-Campus Booster Vaccinations (Third Doses))  
(Reservation Guide)

To All Students:

Please see below for detailed information about on-campus booster vaccinations (third doses) for students.

If you would like to receive a vaccination, please register using the Online Vaccine Reservation System below.

Eligible Recipients: Students who received their second dose at least 6 months ago (including new students)

(All students are eligible regardless of student, including non-degree-seeking students, non-regular employees, etc.)

Scheduled Vaccination Period:

April 18 (Mon) - May 17 (Tue), 12:00-18:00

The vaccination site will be closed on weekends and holidays, including Golden Week (April 29 - May 8).

May 14, 15 and 18 are designated reserve days. Depending on reservations and other factors, vaccinations will be done on these days when deemed necessary.

Vaccination Time: 12:00 - 18:00

Vaccination Site: Toyoda Auditorium / Symposium, Nagoya University (Furo-cho, Chikusa-ku, Nagoya)

Vaccine To Be Used: Takeda/Moderna

Reservation Start Date & Time:

**April 8 (Fri), 2022 at 12:00 a.m. (midnight)**

\*If you have already received your vaccination coupon or are scheduled to receive it soon, please use a general vaccination site run by the local government if possible. Please do not make reservations at both the local general vaccination site and the university vaccination site, as this will delay other people's vaccinations.

\*Spaces are limited, and cancellations will have a significant impact on everyone. We ask in the strongest possible terms that you not cancel your appointment without good reason.

\*Please do not lose the vaccination coupon you receive from the local government. It will be collected at the vaccination site when you receive your vaccination, so please make sure to bring it to your appointment.

\*As a rule, you must have a vaccination coupon in order to receive the vaccination. However, if at least six months have passed since your second dose, you may get vaccinated even if you have not yet received your vaccination coupon.

\*Conditions for eligibility to receive a booster (third dose) vaccination if you have not yet received your vaccination coupon:

- You are at least 18 years of age and affiliated with an institution taking part in the on-campus booster vaccination.

- It has been at least 6 months since your second dose, and you have not yet received a booster (third dose) vaccination.

\*Procedures for people who have not yet received their vaccination coupon (for details, please see the reservation manual posted on the Online Vaccine Reservation System):

- When making a reservation on the system, please make sure to enter "I have not yet received my vaccination coupon" and "date of second dose." (If you do not enter this information, you cannot make a reservation.)

- On the day of your appointment, make sure to bring your Record of Vaccination (the paper with the date of your second dose and the vaccine lot sticker) or COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate App, as well as a form of personal identification (student ID card, health insurance card, driver's license, etc.).

- Take a "vaccination coupon submission envelope" at the vaccination site.

- After being vaccinated, as soon as you receive your vaccination coupon from the local government, make sure to put your vaccination coupon in the "vaccination coupon submission envelope" and promptly send it by mail.

\*Please be careful to dial the correct number.

\*Because some people cannot be vaccinated due to physical or medical conditions, and because there is a risk of side effects after being vaccinated, vaccination is not mandatory. You may freely decide whether or not to receive the vaccine.

Please be considerate and do not discriminate against people who do not get vaccinated.

\*There has been discussion about the development of acute myocarditis/pericarditis after being vaccinated against COVID-19, but the incidence is much higher after COVID-19 infection than it is after vaccination, and the majority of those who do develop symptoms experience only mild symptoms.

Nevertheless, if you have concerns, we recommend that you receive the Pfizer vaccine (please contact your local government-run health center or medical institution for information about Pfizer vaccination sites).

\*If you experience chest pain, palpitations, shortness of breath, or swelling within four days of being vaccinated, please consult with your doctor. Make sure to tell them that you were recently vaccinated.
