- ① Fingerprints form before birth. A person's fingerprints may spread out slightly over the course of their life. But the overall pattern stays the same.
- ② However, criminals have attempted to erase these prints, complicating investigations. What is more, it has been hard to tell whether fingerprints found at a crime scene were left by the criminal or someone else at another time.
- 3 Nearly everyone in the world carries a unique ID right at their fingertips—their fingerprints. That is why some phones can be unlocked with a user's fingertip. And why fingerprints left at a crime scene can help identify the criminal.
- ④ One team has found a way to uncover fingerprints that have been wiped down. The technique relies on the fact that chemicals in a person's fingerprints corrode metal surfaces. That corrosion can be detected even if a print is not visible.
- ⑤ Other scientists have found a way to estimate the age of a fingerprint.

 This can expose whether the fingerprint dates to the time of a crime or before or after.

When someone touches an object, they may leave a stamp of their fingerprint on it. This imprint may be made of oil, dirt, or other substances that were on the person's skin. Forensic scientists have long gathered such fingerprints from crime scenes. Those prints can offer clues about who has been at a certain place and what they did there.

1 James is very proud of his garden where he spends many enjoyable hours working every year. The weeding is hard work, but one of the rewards is the beautiful display of flowers that appears in spring each year. One day, he carefully picked 12 flowers. He used some of the flowers to make a bouquet for his grandmother's birthday party to celebrate her turning 80 years of age. Each flower in the bouquet represented 20 years of her life. Each flower was a different color, and he added in some green leaves to make the colors stand out more. He then chose some flowers to create a wedding anniversary gift for his wife. They had been married 12 years, and each flower he gave her represented three years of marriage. He also gave one flower to his neighbor and then arranged the remainder on his office desk.

How many flowers did he have on his office desk?

2 Mary is considering attending a university in California, and she is trying to calculate the costs with her parents. The price of university has risen considerably over the last few years, so she wants to make sure that it is not a big financial burden on her parents. She needs to determine how much she is going to need to borrow in total through a student loan. The cost of tuition for the university course is \$5,000 per year. The course lasts four years. There are additional processing fees at the beginning of the first year that cost half as much as one year's tuition. She estimates that textbooks and other school supplies will cost \$1,000 per year. Mary knows that she can get government assistance of \$800 per year. Her parents have said that they can afford to give her \$10,000 in total as a gift. In addition, she plans to work part-time and expects to earn \$2,000 per year. She can live with a relative in California, but her living expenses will still be \$2,500 per year.


Mary plans to study at the university for four years. According to her plan, how much money will she need to borrow in total through the student loan?

以下の問いに答えなさい。

食に関する地産地消とは、その地域で採れた食べ物をその地域で消費すること をいいます。地産地消にはメリットがある一方で、課題も残っています。以下の 表は、そのいくつかを記述したものです。

メリットの例

- ・地元の農家や地元企業の経済活動を支えることで、その地域の経済が活気づく。
- ・食品の産地が明確となり、農薬の使用の有無など安全性や品質に関して情報が得やすい。
- ・食品や製品の輸送距離が短いため、輸送に伴う二酸化炭素の排出量が減る。
- ・地域ごとの伝統的な農産物や特産品を支え、地域固有の文化や風土が守られる。
- ・地域の人々のつながりを強化する。

課題の例

- ・地域が限定されるため、天候や季節の影響を受けやすく、一定の供給量を 確保しにくいことがある。
- ・大量に作ることが難しいため、輸入品よりも高くなることがある。
- ・地元で作られる食べ物だけだと手に入る種類が限られ、食の多様性が減少する。
- ・インフラが十分でない地域の場合、流通や保存にかかるコストが高くなる。

このような状況をふまえて、地産地消をさらに推進するアイデアを 60 語から 80 語の英語で具体的に書きなさい。
